Use library databases to find articles from magazines, newspapers, and scholarly journals. Use **QuickSearch** on the library homepage to search across all of Touro's subscription databases, or click on the Database icon to see individual databases  **Databases** listed by subject. *Find Articles*

To read an article, look for a PDF or HTML full-text link, or click  to check for full-text elsewhere or to request a copy.
